Spiced Apricot Cider

- 2 (12-oz.) cans apricot nectar
- 2 c. water
- ¼ c. lemon juice
- ¼ c. sugar
- 2 whole cloves
- 2 (3-inch) cinnamon sticks

In a slow cooker, combine all ingredients; mix well. Cover and cook on low for 2 hours or until cider reached desired temperature. Remove cloves and cinnamon sticks before serving. Yield: 6 servings
