## Brownie Trifle

brownies	3 c. milk
1 box vanilla pudding	2 (8-oz.) cartons of Cool Whip
1 box chocolate pudding	heath bars

Cube brownies into bite-sized pieces. Crush Heath bars. Combine puddings and milk. In a large glass bowl, layer: brownies, half of pudding, 1 carton of Cool Whip, crushed Heath bars. Repeat layers. Chill until ready to serve.

## eScrip - Buy groceries and support the camp...



Our local IGA grocery stores support local organizations through a program called eScrip. Whenever you shop there (or at a number of other places) a percentage of what you spend is given to the charity of your choice. Typically at IGA if you

spend \$50 on groceries every week, IGA gives \$6 to Bethel Mennonite Camp at the end of the month.

Here is how it works. First you need to get a card. You can ask for one at IGA or get one from us here at camp. Then you have to register Bethel Camp as the organization that you want to receive the benefit from your purchase. You can do this online at [www.escrip.com](http://www.escrip.com) or call us and we'll register your card for you.

When that's done, just remember to have the cashier swipe your card before you pay for your groceries. It won't cost you anything and will provide added financial support for camp.

eScrip is a national rewards program so there are other stores - especially online retailers who honor the eScrip card and also give a percentage of any purchase to the charity of your choice. Some businesses you might be familiar with are OfficeMax, American Airlines, Macys, and Eddie Bauer.
